



VC's Award and Dean's Award –2026 Call for Nominations

INTRODUCTION

The Vice Chancellor's Award and the Dean's Award shall be awarded annually to two students with the overall performance (academic and extracurricular activities) in each Faculty under the approved marking scheme. These awards are funded by the Campus and administered by the office of the Deputy Vice Chancellor with the collaboration of faculties, and assistance of the Examination and the Student Affairs branches.

DEFINITION

The Vice Chancellor's Award and the Dean's Award

The best overall student and the second-best student, who completed the academic programme from each faculty shall be selected under the approved marking scheme for the Vice Chancellor's Award and for the Dean's Award, respectively.

THE AWARD

A Medal and a Certificate of Achievement shall be awarded to the recipients under the approved marking scheme at the General Convocation and students of the graduating batch will be eligible for the Award.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- a) Students shall apply for the awards using the Application Form (Annexure 1) published on Saegis LMS. Application form can also be downloaded from the "Student Portal" in Saegis website site, www.saegis.ac.lk.
- b) Students shall submit certified copies of all the documentary evidence with the application.
- c) Students shall submit their application to the Registrar's office **on or before 9th October 2026**.
- d) Students shall prepare and participate in an interview if the selection panel requests.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Applicants must strictly meet the following criteria:

- a) **Academic Standing:** Minimum Second-Class Upper Division (Local) or Merit Pass (International).
- b) **Performance:** Passed all course examinations on the first attempt (no repeats).
- c) **Conduct:** No history of written warnings or disciplinary action.
- d) **Minimum Total Score:** 75+ marks (Vice Chancellor's Award) or 65+ marks (Dean's Award).
